





SIGNS TO TRANSFORM THE CRANIUM BOARD

CATEGORY EXPLANATION CARD

CATEGORY	EXPLANATION
Papa-razzi YELLOW CARDS	These cards are creative activities similar to Pictionary. Team members draw on a piece of paper while the others Guess the word or phrase; for added difficulty, play Blind Paparazzi: the same as Paparazzi but the drawer must have their eyes closed
PONTI FORMATION GREEN CARDS	THESE CARDS HAVE DATA AND FACTS ABOUT THE POPE. CONCLAVIUM: THE PLAYER'S TEAM MEMBERS MUST CHOOSE THE CORRECT ANSWER FROM FOUR MULTIPLE CHOICE ANSWERS. PAPA'S GUESS: THE PLAYER'S TEAM MUST ANSWER THE QUESTION OUTRIGHT DEFENDER OF THE TRUTH: THE PLAYER'S TEAM ANSWERS TRUE OR FALSE TO A STATEMENT
POPE-OLOGY BLUE CARDS	These cards are themed around words and spelling. Papal Speller: team members must spell the word Correctly on the first try without writing down the word. Mission Definition: teams must correctly identify the Definition of a word out of four possibilities. Kingdom's Keys: teams must use a yague hint to fill in the blank for a word or phrase with only some letters Filled in.

Dec. 17, 1936 Born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, to Italian immigrant parents

1957 At age 21, falls gravely ill; eventually severe pneumonia is diagnosed, right lung partially removed

Enters novitiate of the Society of Jesus

March 12, 1960 Takes first vows as Jesuit

1960

Studies humanities in Padre Hurtado, Chile

1961-1963 Studies philosophy at San Miguel Seminary, **Buenos Aires**

1964-1965


Teaches high school literature and psychology at Jesuit secondary school in Santa Fe

1966

Teaches at prestigious Colegio del Salvador secondary school in Buenos Aires

1967-1970

Studies theology at San Miguel seminary



Dec. 13, 1969 Is ordained priest 1970-1971

Spends "tertianship," or Third Probation period of Jesuit formation in Spain

1971-1973

Serves as master of novices and vice chancellor, San Miguel seminary 1973

Takes perpetual profession as Jesuit

1973-1979

Serves as superior of Jesuit province of Argentina and Uruguay 1979-1985

Serves as rector of Colegio Maximo and theology teacher 1986

Goes to Germany to finish doctoral thesis

June 27, 1992

Is ordained auxiliary bishop of Buenos Aires June 3, 1997

Is named coadjutor archbishop

Feb. 28, 1998

Is installed as archbishop of Buenos Aires

2001

Co-presides over Synod of Bishops Feb. 21, 2001

Is elevated to cardinal

2005

Receives second-highest number of votes in conclave that elected Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger as pope

2005-2011

Serves as president, Argentine Bishops Conference



March 13, 2013 Is elected pope by conclave of 115

cardinals
