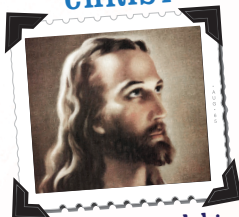
## FAST FACTS

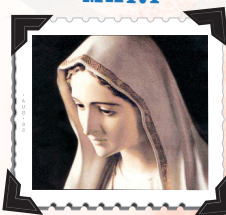

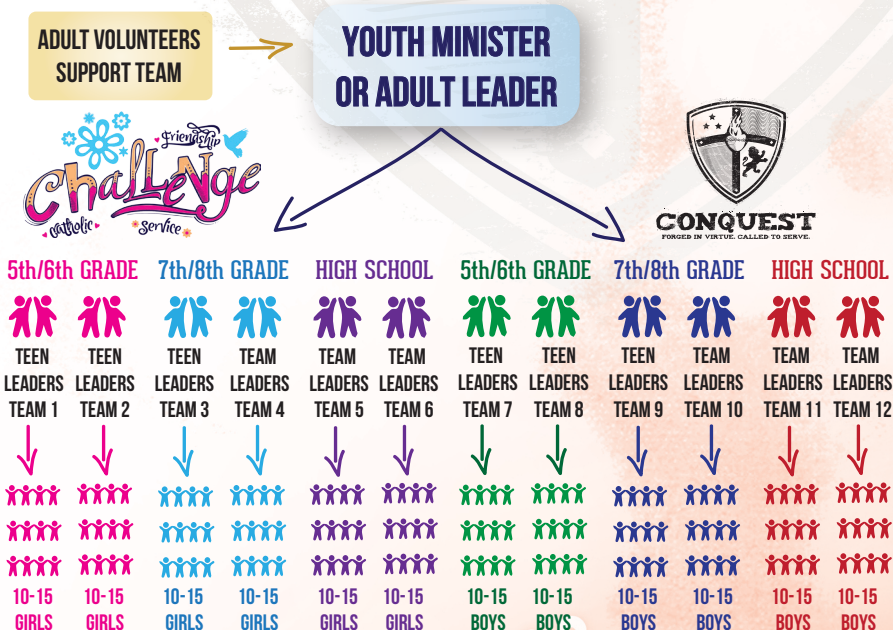

# WHAT DO WE MEAN BY TEAM BASED AND TEEN LED?

Challenge and Conquest are designed so that you organize your youth group into smaller teams of about 10-15 teens, who are around the same age. Each team is led by one or two teen leaders who are usually 2 or 3 years older than the group they lead. This is small group mentoring or peer ministry where everything is done in teams especially the weekly activities & service projects. The youth minister and adult leaders work with the teen leaders, training them and helping them prepare to lead their team activities each week. In this way, the youth group may be large in number but no one will feel lost in the crowd because they are part of a team with a team leader looking out for them.

Peer mentoring is not only a life changing experience for the teen leaders, it truly makes an impact on the younger teens when they learn about their faith and see positive role models in their team leaders, who are only a few years older than they are.



# WHAT MAKES THE CHALLENGE & CONQUEST CURRICULUM UNIQUE?

## QUESTION OF THE WEEK

In Challenge and Conquest, our curriculum is based off the questions teens have about God, their faith, the world, and themselves. The theme for each week is a question. The weekly activity in the Team Leader Guidebooks gives the team leader a path to lead the team down and discover the answer to the question of the week.

First, they turn to the YOUCAT to find a solid catechetical answer to the question. Then the team leader goes through the 6 parts of the Challenge or Conquest Weekly Meeting where they gain a better understanding of the question of the week.

Each weekly meeting has at least one game, activity or experience; relevant video clips; a gospel reflection to find how Jesus answered the question and at least one saint or story of someone who discovered the answer in their own life. The games are not listed on the charts.

The curriculum and guide for each weekly activity is in the Team Leader Guidebooks but we also have a CD or USB drive and online resource center with hundreds of printouts and additional material that to help the team leader lead the meeting.

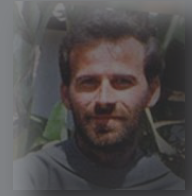

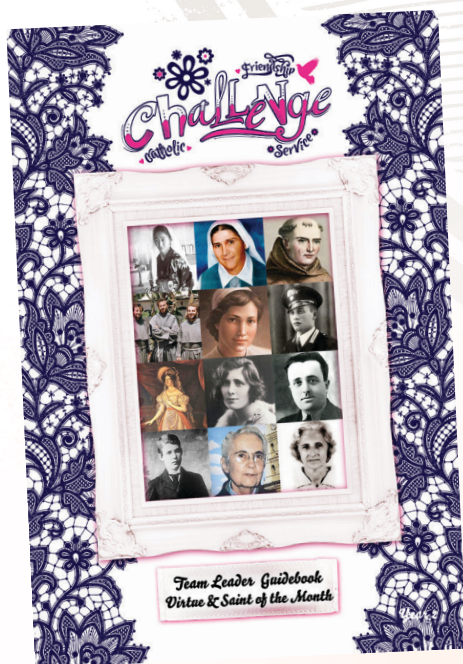

Challenge also offers an additional team leader guidebook in each team leader kit that focuses on the Virtue and Saint of the Month. This guidebook has 10 Challenge Monthly Meetings focusing on that specific virtue and the saints found in the Challenge calendar. August & September and are combined into one meeting and so is June & July. The activities, games and content will help the Team Leaders and girls learn more about Christian virtues and modern day saints. It is meant to be used each month as a compliment to the regular curriculum, ideally in the first meeting of the month. These activities have a craft each month that the teams can do. There are also printable virtue cards for each month that can be used to motivate the girls to practice the virtue of the month each day. These cards can be found on the Team Leader USB or online resource center.

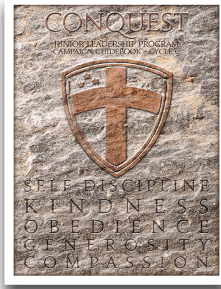
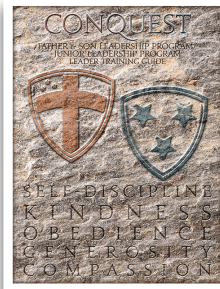
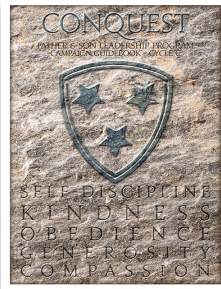

The Conquest Father & Son Program and Junior Leadership Program are meant to be run by dad volunteers, and have their own unique Conquest materials for each age group. This includes Adult Leader Guidebooks and USB drive with materials to lead the younger boys, t-shirts, cinch bags, and commitment cards specifically designed for the younger age group. Both Programs include point chips and points tracker posters to keep the boys motivated each month through campaign competitions. The saints & virtues for this year's cycle are Obedience- St Maximilian Kolbe, Kindness- St John Paul II, Generosity- St Padre Pio, Self Discipline- St John Vianney and Compassion- Blessed Mother Teresa. The Junior Program is focused on the boys learning more about their Catholic Faith in a fun way. This year the program will include books about the following aspects of our faith: Ten Commandments, The Holy Family, The Angels, Celebrating Lent and The Works of Mercy. The Father Son Program features videos that help the boys understand the virtue of the month through stories in the Bible. This year we will focus on Moses, Joseph,, Jonah and the Whale, Noah's Ark and the Good Samaritan. Each virtue campaign also includes coloring pages that you can print and send home.

#### ACTIVITY 1: BANDAID RELAY

##### BANDAID



##### RELAY

Discussion: This game is for the girls to see that each person is important in affecting the lives of other people. Each person on the team can effect the others. Ask the girls if they remember the story of the Good Samaritan in the Bible. Have them explain what happens to the poor man on the side of the road. Make sure they bring up the following points: (1) He was hurt by someone and left alone. (2) Several people passed him by and did nothing or ignored him. (3) – the enemy of his people- stopped and helped him. (4) The Samaritan went beyond the call of duty to help this man, feeding him and giving him shelter.

Activity: Divide the team into two groups. Provide each team member with one band-aid and one strip of toilet paper (approximately 10 sheets long). The toilet paper represents bandages (real gauze bandages work best, but can be expensive). Each team chooses one "injured man" This team member will go to one end of the room and lay down on the floor. All other team members will remain on the opposite end of the room and will represent the Good Samaritan. The game is played as a relay race. Each team member will take a turn running to the other side of room and placing either their band aid and "bandage" on the injured man and running back to the line and tagging the next team member. After the last team member returns, all team members will run the floor, pick up the injured man and return him to the other side of the room. The first team to get back on the other side of the room wins.

### 4 Connect → To Christ: Gospel Reflection



Remember – the gospel reflection is a moment to help the girls understand how Jesus responded to this week's question with his life or his words in the gospel. Choose one of the girls to read the passage.

**GOSPEL READING** Greatest Commandment Matthew 22:24-30

When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together, and one of them a scholar of the law tested him by asking, "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?" He said to him, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments."

#### GOSPEL INSIGHTS

Explain the gospel passage to your team so that they can better understand the life of Jesus

Maybe sometimes we think that everyone treated Jesus nicely and listened to what he had to say. That was not the case. In this passage the Pharisees and Sadducees were arguing (they did not agree on everything just like Republicans and Democrats) and they were trying to get Jesus to choose sides. He did not so they brought a scholar of the law – otherwise known as a lawyer – and had him ask Jesus about which law was most important. This is a tricky question because there were 10 commandments and they were all important in one way or another. The Pharisees knew that there was really no correct answer to this question. Jesus knew they were trying to trap him or confuse him. So Jesus went to the heart of the matter and did not try to pick one of the ten commandments. Instead he summarized all of the commandments in two simple new commandments – love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and mind and love your neighbor as yourself. In fact the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the YouCAT explain the commandments in these two categories. (Try to put all the commandments into these two categories with your team. For example, You shall not kill falls under the second commandment.) So in this passage Jesus realizes that this man is asking him – what is the most important thing I need to do in this life? Why are we here? What is our purpose? Jesus' answer gives us the key to our mission here on this earth: loving God and loving other people. Everything falls into those categories.

#### St. Laura of Catherine of Siena



Laura Montoya was born in 1874 in Columbia. During the Colombian Civil War, her father was killed, and the family was left in poverty. So, Laura was sent to live with her grandmother. When Laura was 16, to help her family in its financial difficulties and she went to school to become an elementary school teacher. She did not limit herself to educating the students simply in academic knowledge, but she helped to spread Gospel teaching and values.

She also felt called to the religious life, her heart set on God alone, and dreamed of one day becoming a cloistered nun; but at the same time, though she felt growing within her the desire to spread the Gospel to the farthest corners of the earth, to those who had never met Jesus Christ. Laura wanted to work with those who were forgotten because racial discrimination. In 1914, she founded the Congregation of the Missionary Sisters of Mary Immaculate and St. Catherine of Siena. She left the city with four other young women and went to the rural areas to live among the native Indians.

She was known for her work with Indigenous peoples, and as a strong role model for South American girls. She taught by example "to educate with love" as the only way to teach the Indians, the way which allowed access into their heart and culture to bring them Jesus Christ. She spent her whole life fulfilling that mission. The last nine years of her life were lived in a wheelchair. She died after a prolonged illness in 1949. Today her Missionary Sisters work in 19 countries throughout America, Africa and Europe. She was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 2004 and canonized by Pope Francis in May 2013.

### WHY DO I NEED TO GO TO CONFESSION?





**#316** *HOW CAN WE DISTINGUISH SERIOUS SINS (MORTAL SINS) FROM LESS SERIOUS (VENIAL) SINS?* Serious sin destroys the divine power of love in a person's heart, without which there can be no eternal beatitude. Hence it is also called mortal sin. Serious sin breaks with God, whereas venial sin only strains the relationship with him. A serious sin cuts a person off from God. One requirement for such a sin is that it be opposed to an important value, for instance, directed against life or God (for example, murder, blasphemy, adultery, and so on) and that it be committed with full knowledge and full consent. Venial sins are opposed to secondary values (honor, truth, property, and so on) or are committed without full knowledge of their seriousness or without full consent of the will. Such sins disrupt the relationship with God but do not sever it.

**ST CHARLES BOROMEO**  
St Charles Borromeo understood the importance of put your faith into practice and living your beliefs. He not only realized the importance of confession in his own life, but he dedicated his efforts to teach others about the faith by opening schools, parishes, and ultimately helping write the catechism.
