YOUTH PROGRAMS

FATHER & SON VIRTUE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

K-2nd grade

The 5-7 age range is an ideal time to introduce boys to the concept of leadership. They are extremely impressionable and curious when it comes to understanding what it means to be a man. Interaction with solid, virtuous examples of adolescents, young adults, and dads gives the boys a wonderful opportunity to fulfill such a quest. By means of mentoring, the boys are guided through the age-appropriate development of virtues such as respect, self-discipline, and obedience all while developing leadership skills.

JUNIOR VIRTUE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

3rd-4th grade

The 8-10 age range is a pivotal time in a boy's life. Waiting on the threshold of his young life are the adolescent years which are highlighted by a sense of independence amid physiological, intellectual, emotional, social, and other types of changes. Therefore, it is imperative to assist him in learning and applying the basic truths of a virtuous, masculine life now. These truths will help him build a solid foundation that cannot be uprooted by the pressure of the world later. Of greatest importance in this quest for a virtuous foundation in the boy's life is a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, his savior and friend.

CONQUEST CLUB PROGRAM

5th-12th grades

With the intellectual formation needs of youth addressed by the education system, Conquest seeks to help parents and parishes by providing spiritual formation for youth facing a critical stage of their maturing process. At this time, adolescents will tend to base their identity on popular figures in music, sports, entertainment, or even on brands of clothing. Conquest helps these young men to become Christ-centered and care for others in order to find true and lasting interior happiness. Conquest clubs are an alternative to the culture that continually transmits poor values to adolescents. In the club, boys find a happy, healthy, and attractive environment where they will form themselves in the fundamental aspects of their personality and develop their aptitude for leadership. They can then effectively launch themselves into dynamic social and cultural works of outreach as well as participate actively and creatively in the club. The club develops intensive team life, with each team being directed by a team leader which is a young man a few years older than the team he is leading.
