Emil grew up on a farm in Kansas, and shortly after being ordained a priest he joined the US Army as a chaplain. He was serving over 19,000 service men and women in Wheeler, GA. He was ultimately sent to Japan, and was known to celebrate Mass on an Army jeep as it was the only place available. He was sent to Korea and ended up in a prison camp in North Korea during the war. He was a hero to many prisoners as he helped many become good Catholics before their deaths. He died in 1951 in prison. He was a best friend to so many people in his life.
