Scavenger Hunt Key

Since we want to make this as easy as possible for you, here we have a key with where to hide each clue and the solution to all the problems. If you change up hiding places, do not forget to change the clues!

Where to place clues:

- 1. Place this clue where you meet.
- 2. Place this clue right below the tabernacle in the church.
- 3. Affix this clue to the wheels of whatever vehicle you came to Conquest in or on.
- 4. Put this clue under whichever seat the lightest boy on the team used for the meeting. (you can do this once the boys head out after clues 2 and 3.
- 5. Put this clue on the door to the parish office.
- 6. Put this clue in the corner of the gym.
- 7. Put this in the fifth pew back from the sanctuary in the church.
- 8. On you: but they need to ask you the fateful question and actually do it a little before they receive this clue.
- 9. Treasure: put it under third closest tree to main door of the church.
