#67: WHAT IS SIN? At the core of sin is a rejection of God and the refusal to accept his love. This is manifested in a disregard for his commandments.

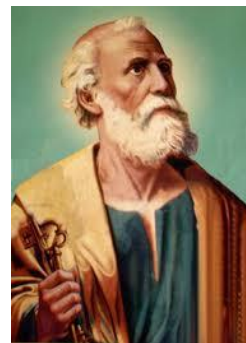
#318: WHAT ARE VICES? Vices are negative habits that deaden and dull the conscience, incline a person to evil, and habitually prepare him for sin.
