ST. ISAAC JOGUES

St. Isaac Jogues was born in France in 1607 and in 1624 he entered the Jesuits. He became a missionary to Canada (then called New France) and was captured, tortured, and enslaved by the Mohawk Iroquois. During his enslavement, has tried to teach them Christianity. He was able to escape and return to France. Back in France, he received special permission to celebrate Mass, even though his hands had been mutilated by the Mohawks. He eventually went back to Canada to finish his missionary work and bring the Gospel to the people there. He was killed by the Mohawk's on October 18, 1646.
