ST. YINCENT DE PAUL

After being ordained a priest in 1600, St. Vincent was captured and enslaved by Turkish pirates. He converted his owner to Christianity and escaped back to Rome where he became a chaplain for the royal court. He began preaching to peasants on the estate in 1625 and founded a society of missionary priests called the Vincentians. He had a great heart full of compassion, humility, and generosity, and his heart today is still incorrupt. The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul, a charitable organization dedicated to the service of the poor, was established in 1833.



CAMERON PETERS

In 2007, 16 yr old Cameron Peters saw a house on fire and stopped to help. After calling 911, he went into the home without regard for his own safety and successfully saved 8 children from the fire. He was honored in 2007 by the NBA Summer League for heroism.
