#349: THE TEN COMMANDMENTS ARE:

6. You shall not commit adultery. This includes sins against modesty.
7. You shall not steal. This includes using your money wisely and being fair with others.

10. You shall not cover your neighbor's goods. This includes envying people.

ST. PAUL MIKI

He was born in Japan in 1562 and became a religious brother with the Jesuits. He preached and converted many to Catholicism, but was jailed with 2 others, forced to march 600 miles and all 3 were crucified on Holy Mountain in Japan.

Edward was born in Italy in 1907 and during WWII he helped Jews by providing them with false documents and IDs so they could escape Nazi death camps. He was sentenced to a concentration camp where he died in 1944.
