ST. BERNADETTE

St. Bernadette was born in Lourdes, France in 1844. She lived in great poverty. On February 11, 1858, when Bernadette was only 14 years old, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to her in a cave on the banks of the Gave River near Lourdes. People did not believe her and she was threatened to say it was not true. She would not say this and on February 25, 1858, a spring emerged from the cave and the waters were discovered to be miraculous, capable of healing the sick and lame. A church was built on this site according to the revelations she heard from Mary, and many people came to the spring, which has produced 27,000 gallons of water each week, and are healed. Bernadette became a nun with the Sisters of Notre Dame and died in 1879. She was canonized in 1933. Her body is encased in glass and is incorrupt to the present day.
