#33: What does it mean to say that God is love? God is love and there is nothing created that is not carried and surrounded by his infinite goodness.

#49: Does God guide the world and my life? God guides everything along the paths that only he knows, leading it to perfection. God influences both the great events of history and also the little events of our personal life.

#338: What is grace? By grace we mean God's free, loving gift to us, his helping goodness, the vitality that comes from him. God devotes himself entirely to us and communicates himself to us in grace. Grace is everything God grants us, without our deserving it in the least.

#339: What does God's grace do to us? God's grace makes us capable of living in God's love and of acting on the basis of this love. Grace helps us to know, to will, and to do everything that leads us to what is good, to God, and to heaven (actual grace). Grace comes about in a special way in the sacraments.

Cardinal Nguyen van Thuan

One day he prayed to Jesus: "I am happy here, in this cell because you are here with me, because you want me to live here with you. I have spoken much in my lifetime: now I speak no more.
