### **St Toribio Romo gonzales**

St Toribio decided to become a priest during a time of persecution of the Church in the Cristero War. He put his life at risk every day to bring the sacraments to people and specifically travelled with he Eucharist to reach people in outlying towns. He knew that Jesus in the Eucharist gives us strength and nourishment in life.



#### St Jose Robles Hurtado

Like St Toribio, Jose Robles became a priest during the Cristero War when the government was persecuting Catholic clergy. He had a strong devotion to the Sacred Heart and the Eucharist. HE wanted to make it clear to the people of Mexico that Christ was the King of the hearts of the people of Mexico. Promoting this love for the Sacred Heard and the Eucharist is what led to his martyrdom.
