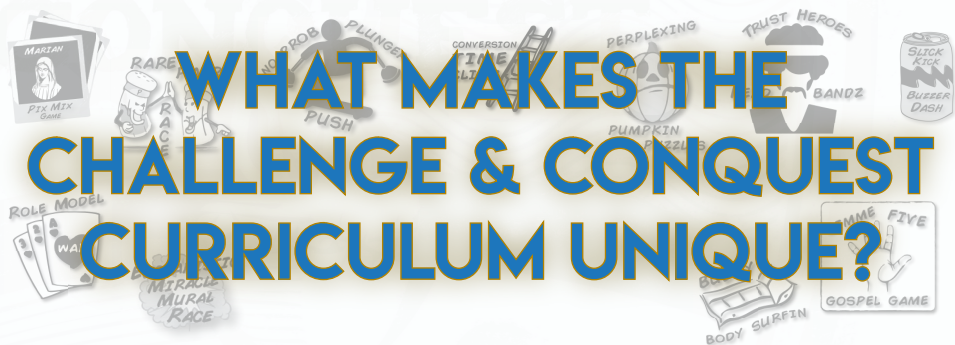
WHAT DO WE MEAN BY TEAM BASED AND TEEN LED?

Challenge and Conquest are designed so that you organize your youth group into smaller teams of about 10-15 teens, who are around the same age. Each team is led by one or two teen leaders who are usually 2 or 3 years older than the group they lead. This is small group mentoring & peer ministry where everything is done in teams especially the weekly activities & service projects. The youth minister & adult leaders work with the teen leaders training them & helping them prepare to lead their team activities each week. In this way the youth group could be large in number but no one will feel lost in the crowd because they are part of a team with a team leader looking out for them.

Peer mentoring is not only a life changing experience for the teen leaders, it truly makes an impact on the younger teens when they learn about their faith and see positive role models in their team leaders, who are only a few years older than they are.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

In Challenge and Conquest, our curriculum is based off the questions teens have about God, their faith, the world, and themselves. The theme for each week is a question. The weekly activity in the Team Leader Guidebooks gives the team leader a path to lead the team down and discover the answer to the question of the week.

First, they turn to the YOUCAT to find a solid catechetical answer to the question. Then the team leader goes through the 6 parts of the Challenge or Conquest Weekly Meeting where they gain a better understanding of the question of the week.

Each weekly meeting has at least one game, activity or experience; relevant video clips; a gospel reflection to find how Jesus answered the question and at least one saint or story of someone who discovered the answer in their own life. The games are not listed on the charts.

The curriculum and guide for each team's weekly activity is in the Team Leader Guidebooks but we also have an online resource center with hundreds of printouts and additional material to help the team leader lead the meeting effectively.

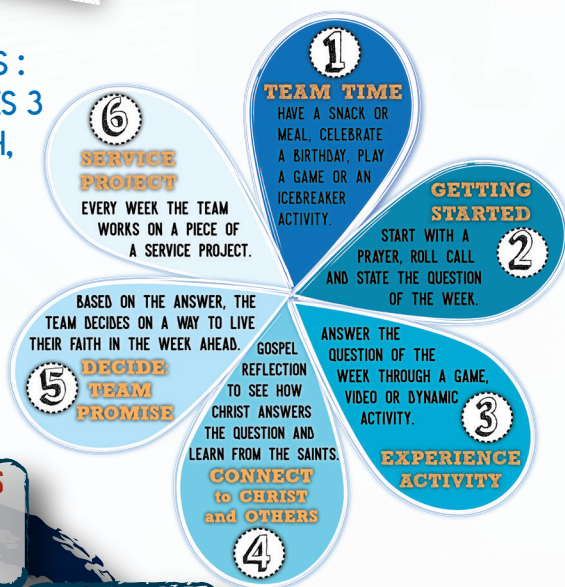

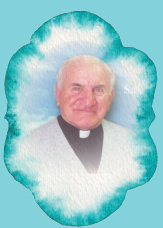

LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

The Conquest Father & Son Program and Junior Leadership Program are meant to be run by dad volunteers, and have their own unique Conquest materials for each age group. This includes Adult Leader Guidebooks and USB drive with materials to lead the younger boys, t-shirts, cinch bags, & commitment cards specifically designed for the younger age group. Both Programs include point tracker booklets to keep the boys motivated each month through campaign competitions.

The Junior Program is focused on the boys learning more about their Catholic Faith in a fun way through stories of the saints. The Father Son Program features videos that help the boys understand the virtue of the month through stories in the Bible. Each virtue campaign also includes virtue stickers that the boys can add to their commitment cards. There are coloring pages that you can print and send home.

Challenge Jr is led by Adult Leaders, with the help from teen mentors who are usually Challenge members. The Curriculum each year focuses on five virtues with five saints. Each week the girls learn about how to live that virtue either with God, at home, at school or with friends. The Curriculum can be found in the Adult Leader Guidebook and the kit for leaders also includes virtue posters and virtue stickers to help the girls follow along.

Challenge Jr believes in the power of positive recognition and creating memories. To do this, we offer virtue charms, holy cards and new bracelets to help keep the girls excited about learning and living their Catholic faith and Christian virtue.

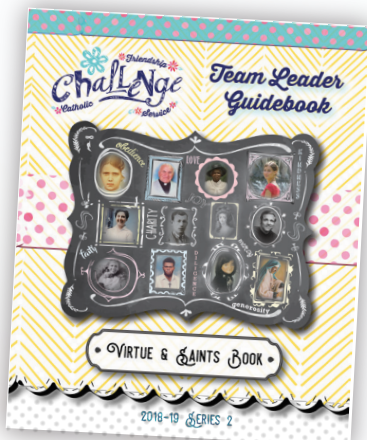

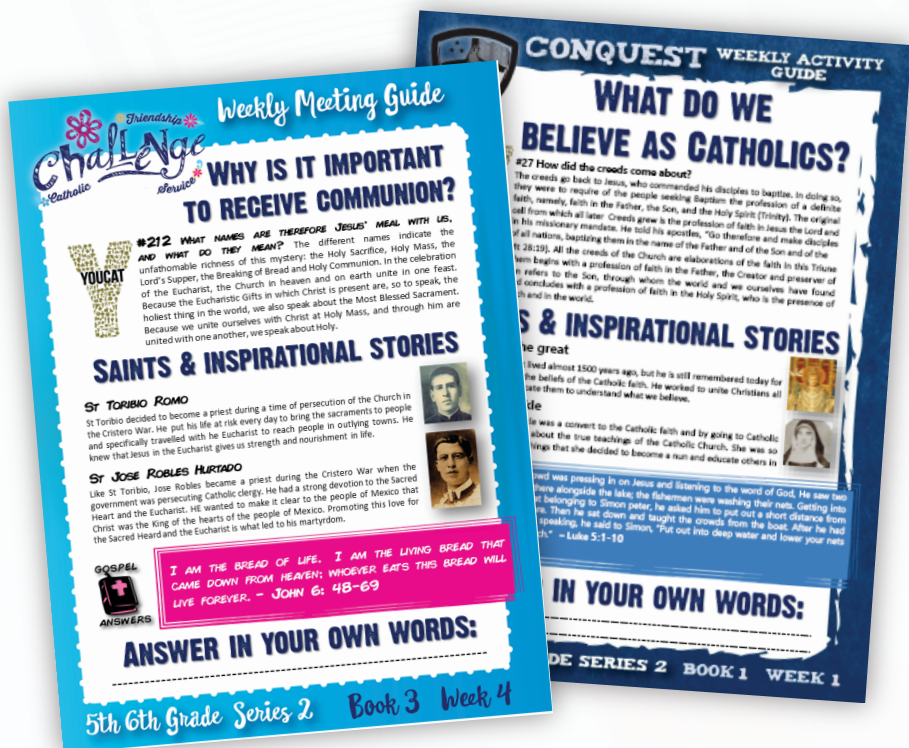

It is meant to be used each month as a compliment to the regular curriculum, and ideally at the first meeting of the month.

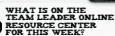
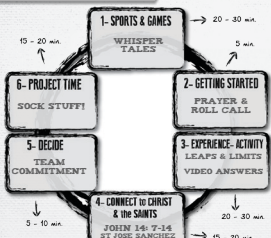

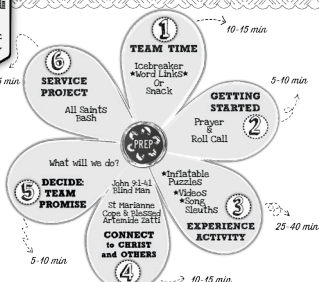

WHY DO I NEED TO GO TO CONFESSION?

3 EXPERIENCE: DYNAMIC ACTIVITY

FIB FACTOR

CHECK IT OUT:

Have you ever heard of the game Box of Lies or Balderdash? This is a combination of them both!

MAKE IT HAPPEN:

- Set Up:** Before the game, you will need to print out the Fly Factor Cards. You will need to boxes. In each box you need to put one Fly Factor card and a random strange item (see suggestions below). Set up a long table with one chair at each end. In the middle of the table should be a poster board or a large sheet of paper. On the left side of the poster board, you will need to write a score board. Stack the boxes beside the table with numbers on them.
- 1. Explanation:** Split the group into two teams. Each team will have one player represent their team. The first player will be the Fly Factor. The other player will be the Fly Factor's opponent. You will select a box and take the item out without showing their opponent, but they will show the crowd. Instruct the crowd not say anything. The person who has selected the item then choose to either keep the item or give it to their opponent. If they choose to give it to their opponent, they will need to confess out loud. The goal of the game is trick your opponent and get them to guess incorrectly. If they guess correctly, they are given a point for the item and a point for the fact. If not, the "liar" is given a point. Each team will have a score board. The Fly Factor will be the one to write down the points and take up the facts and files about the confession. The next set of players then go, with the opposite team this time choosing a box. Then two more players will take over each box has a turn or you can have more than two teams.
- 2. Suggested bizarre items in boxes:** Stuffed animal in mouse trap, Goldfish crackers box with glittery pieces, Live bug in paper envelope, Turkey basket with legumes people in it, picture of Spiderman with a dead mouse, metal can of beans, a small box of bubble gum, a small box of bubble gum, a small box of spaghetti noodles and skittles, yellow glue decorated like a rooster, frozen DVD case from

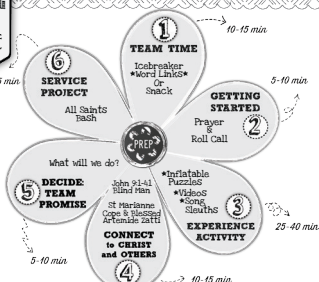

Activity 3: Mob Charades

MOB
CHARADES

Set Up: Before the game you can will need to make a sign with a poster board and appoint one person to be the cue card person. Print off the Mob Charade Words from the Team Leader Resource Center and have the Cue Card person tape them to the sign for each turn. You will need a large timer or a person who is keeping track of time. Mob Charade letters "COUNT" and "TRUST!". Give one letter to each girl on the team and scramble to find their team mates who make up the same word. Have something to keep for each team (stickers, balloons, candy)

Explanation: The game is very simple. You call up the person with the first letter of the word from the team you ("C") and they come to the front and face the two teams. Instead of acting out the word, they need to guess what the charade word is while all of the other team members act on the timer. The cue card person will run behind the guesser, showing the word to the crowd. When the timer starts, everyone needs to act out the word. The opposing team may try to act out distracting things. No talking aloud from the crowd. If they guess correctly, the team gets the point. If they do not guess, no point. Any cheating from the other team means they will lose a point. The team leader can give a hint. The first team to reach 10 points wins. The beginning of each turn to learn about trust. The winning team is able to give the other team a hint.
