What are the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?



You rejected this person, all his works, and all his empty promises at Baptism.

Who is Satan?



These two other Sacraments, together with Baptism make up the Sacraments of Christian Initiation.

What are the Eucharist and Confirmation?



For baptism to be valid, this type of water must be poured on a person, or they must be immersed in it.

What is "Any"? (hot or cold, holy water or lake water, salted or unsalted)



These people can baptize someone "in case of necessity" (that is when a priest, deacon or bishop is unable to).

Who is any <u>other</u> person, whether baptized or not? (you can't baptize yourself)

These are the two parts of the Mass.

What are the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist?



At the mass we relive the one Sacrifice of Christ on this hill.

What is Calvary or Golgotha? (either is acceptable)



Reception of Holy Communion at Mass washes away these sins.

What are Venial Sins?



This term describes what happens to the bread and wine when the priest says "This is my body" and "This is my blood."

What is Transubstantiation or Consecration? (Either is valid)



This prayer in mass, called the doxology, concludes the Eucharistic Prayer.

What is "Through him, and with him, and in him, to you, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, is all honor and glory, for ever and ever."?

What is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ?



At this ceremony, Jesus instituted the Eucharist.

What is the Last Supper?



When Jesus is exposed for Solemn Adoration, he is placed in one of these beautiful, large gold objects.

What is a Monstrance?



According to 1324 of the Catechism, The Eucharist is the and of the Christian Life.

What are Source and Summit?



In this chapter of the Gospel, Jesus says, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever."

Who are Priests? (The Pope and all bishops are also priests)



The Seal of Confession prevents a priest from doing this.

What is mentioning anything you said in confession to anyone?



This is the frequency Conquest members are encouraged to approach the Sacrament of Confession.

How often is every two weeks?



This is the proper name for the sorrow we have for our sin and our desire for repentance; it is perfect if done out of love of God, and imperfect if done out of fear of Hell.

What is Contrition?



These are the central words of the absolution the priest gives you during confession.

What is "I absolve you from your sins in the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"?

This is the number of Sacraments in the Catholic Church.

What is Seven?



This is the Second Sacrament of Healing, sometimes mistakenly called "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction."

What is the "Anointing of the Sick"?



These are the 3 Sacraments that confer character on the soul and can hence only be received once.

What are Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders?



This is defined by the Catechism as "An efficacious sign of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us through the work of the Holy Spirit"

What is a Sacrament?



This is the name given to the oil used in Confirmation. It is blessed by the bishop during the Chrism Mass during Holy Week.
