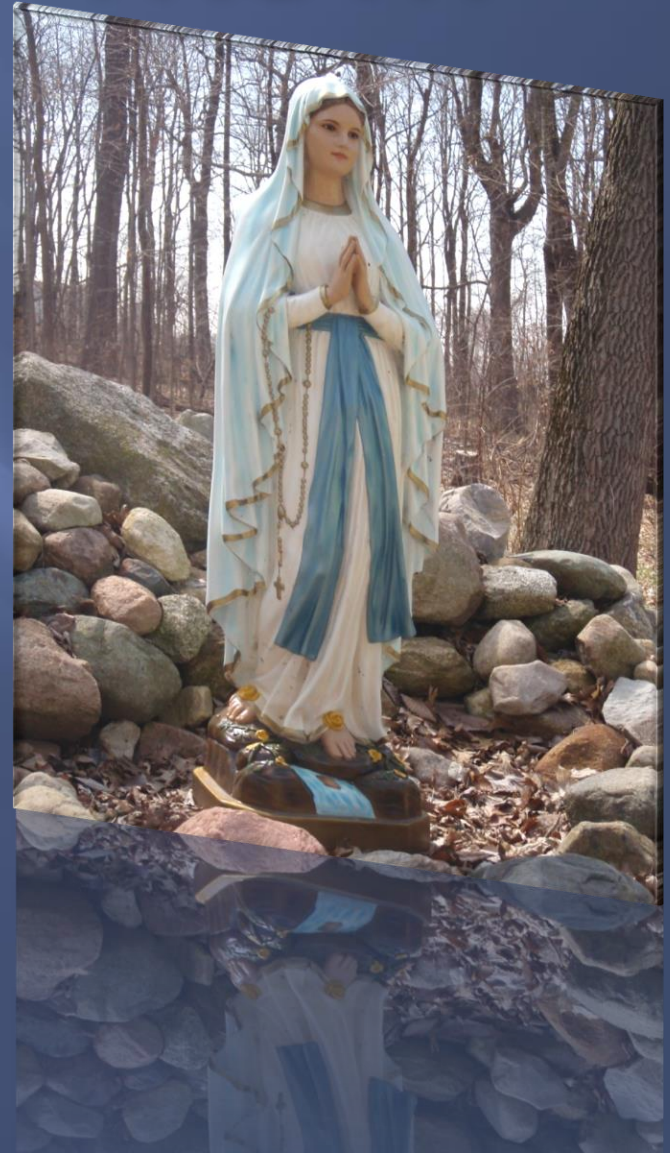
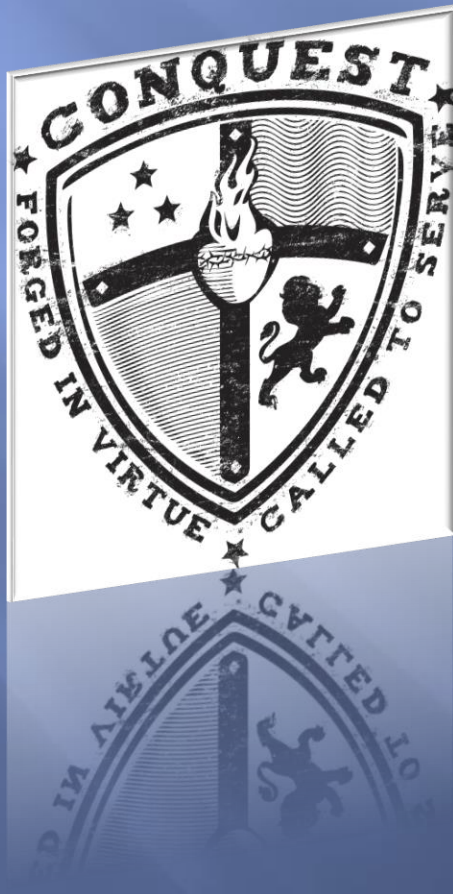


OUR LADY OF TRUTH

Mary was conceived without sin.

Mary had no original or personal sins.



*Mary is the Mother of God because
she is the Mother of Jesus Christ.*

TRUE or FALSE?

In declaring Christ as true God and true man, the council of Nicea gave Mary the title of *Theotokos*, declaring she was the Mother of God.



*Mary is the new Eve because she
said yes where Eve said no.*

TRUE or FALSE?

Mary regenerated us from the fall of Adam and Eve
by her obedience to God's call.



*Mary is not our Mother because she
did not give birth to us.*

We are adopted Children of Mary.



Mary is the Coredemptrix because she participates in Christ's saving work.

TRUE or FALSE?

Mary participates in Christ's salvation as we all do by winning grace but she does this in a special way because of her special relationship with Jesus.



*Mary is Mediatrix of many graces
but not sacramental grace.*

Mary is the Mediatrix of all grace.



Mary was Jewish and fulfilled all the demands of that religion.

Mary's Life (in the Bible)



Traditionally, Mary was Born in Nazareth.

TRUE or FALSE?

Even though Joseph was from Nazareth, traditionally Mary is said to have been born in Aim Karem near Jerusalem.



Traditionally, Mary's parents are known as Joachim and Anne.

TRUE or FALSE?



*The Angel Nathaniel came to Mary
to announce that she would be
Jesus' mother.*

TRUE or FALSE?

It was the angel Gabriel who announced this.



Mary sang her Magnificat at the home of her cousin Elizabeth.

TRUE or FALSE?

Mary went to visit Elizabeth, and help her with her child, St John the Baptist, right after she was told she would be Jesus' mother.



*When Mary gave birth to Jesus,
angels announced it to nearby
shepherds.*

TRUE or FALSE?

They sang: “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace
among those with whom he is pleased!” (Luke 2:14)



The Prophet Simeon blessed Jesus at the time of his purification and told Mary of the sword that would pierce her soul.

God promised Simeon that he would not die before he saw the Messiah.



The disciple Peter stood under the cross with Mary.

TRUE or FALSE?

It was John who stood under the cross, Peter had run away after he denied Jesus.



The Disciples excluded Mary from their prayer in the upper room before Pentecost, as they wanted to be alone.

The Acts of the Apostles (1:14) clearly states that Mary was there praying with them. She can help us stay constant in prayer too.

*Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared to
St. Juan Diego on Tepeyac Hill.*

*The Tilma on which Mary appeared
was St Juan Diego's Tablecloth.*

TRUE or FALSE?

The Tilma was part of St Juan Diego's clothing.



*Our Lady asked St Juan Diego to
pick roses and bring them to
Bishop Zumarraga.*

TRUE or FALSE?

The type of roses he picked do not grow in Mexico nor at that time of year. This proved to the bishop that it was truly Mary speaking to St Juan Diego.



The Tilma on which our Lady of Guadalupe appeared is made of durable and long lasting fabric.

TRUE or FALSE?

It is a miracle that the Tilma has survived as usually that material rots or disintegrates in 15 or 20 years. They have even tried to make replicas on the same material but they don't last long.



Our Lady of Lourdes was visible to thousands at the same time.

TRUE or FALSE?

Only Bernadette saw Mary but they all believed because of Bernadette's reaction and the miraculous spring.



*At Lourdes, Mary called herself the
Immaculate Conception*

TRUE or FALSE?

On March 25, 1858 Mary said “I am the Immaculate Conception.”
The dogma had been defined by Pope Pius IX four years previously.



*When our Lady appeared in Fatima,
the sun did loops.*

This is called the day when the sun danced.



*At all of the Apparitions Mentioned,
Mary encouraged Prayer and
Penance.*

TRUE or FALSE?

Mary had seven sorrows, they are: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight to Egypt, the loss of Jesus at age 12, meeting Jesus on the way of the cross, the death of Jesus, the removal of Jesus from the cross, and Jesus' burial.



*Mary's "Yes" at the Annunciation
was required because God
requested it.*

TRUE or FALSE?

Mary's "Yes" was the freest act ever taken. It brought our salvation but Mary was totally free to say "No."



*Mary was the first and only living
Tabernacle.*

TRUE or FALSE?

Because she held Jesus inside her womb as a Tabernacle holds the Eucharist, we can say that Mary was a Tabernacle.



After Jesus' death, Mary lived alone.
