- 1. What do Islam, Christianity and Judaism have in common? They all believe in one god (monotheistic.)
- 2. Who founded Islam (Muslim religion)? Mohammed.
- 3. Who founded Judaism? Isaac and Jacob.
- 4. Who founded Christianity? Jesus Christ. *** SHOW THE team CHART #1 and explain it.
- **5. Did Jesus want everyone to be part of the one true church?** Yes, he said "Go, then; teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." (Mt. 28:19)
- 6. True or false: Christianity was the first religion. False. ***SHOW THE team CHART #2

- **7. Was the Catholic church ever split in two?** Yes. It is called the great schism of the east and west. It happened in 1054 when the leader of the eastern Catholic churches did not want to follow the pope. From that point on the Catholic church was referred to as Roman Catholic (following the pope in Rome or west) and the Eastern Orthodox Church (following the patriarch).
- **8. What does protestant mean?** It comes from the word "protest or disagree".
- 9. True or false: there are over 33,000 protestant denominations in the world. They were all started by men who believed a little bit differently than their church. True. ***SHOW THE team CHART #3
- 10. True or false: Luther, an Augustinian monk, decided to leave the Church because he did not believe that man could save himself with the help of grace. According to him, nothing that we do has merit before God, since we are sinners. God has chosen the number of people to save. Furthermore, Luther said that the sacraments were nothing more than symbols. True.
- **11. Why did King Henry VIII start the Anglican Church?** Henry VIII wished to divorce his wife and remarry, and the Pope forbade him to do so. King Henry formed his own Church (the Anglican Church).

- 12. Why do atheists attack the Catholic church? They attack the Catholic church because they do not believe in god and they try to attack the strongest church in the world.
- **13. Why do Jewish people dislike the Catholic church?** Christianity and the Catholic church say that Jesus was the messiah and the Jewish religion is still waiting for the messiah. They believe that Jesus was a holy man or prophet.
- 14. True or false: people with loose moral values dislike the Catholic church because the Church teaches us to live not based on what we feel, but on what is good and right.

 True. Being Christian means living the commandments and not doing what the world says is right.
- **15. Why do pro-choice people dislike the Catholic church?** Because the Catholic church defends human life and does not support abortion or euthanasia.
- 16. True or false. Catholics are human beings so they will make mistakes but we have confession and can come back to God. True.
- 17. True or false: there are over 17,000 parishes in the united states and 40, 000 Catholic priests. True.

Atheists do not believe in God so they are not part of a religion.








