


Good Friday is celebrated by flying kites to symbolize Christ's ascension into Heaven

Italy (Florence)





Locals celebrate a 350-year-old Easter tradition where an ornate cart packed with fireworks is led through the streets of the city by people in colorful 15th century costumes, before the Archbishop then lights a fuse during Easter Mass that leads outside to the cart and sparks a lively fireworks display.









Finland





Children in this Scandinavian country dress up like witches and go begging for chocolate eggs in the streets with madeup faces and scarves around their heads, carrying bunches of willow twigs decorated with feathers









Poland

ENT + LENT







Pouring water on one another is an Easter tradition called Śmigus-dyngus. On Easter Monday, boys try to drench other people with buckets of water, squirt guns or anything they can get their hands on. The refreshing tradition has its origins in the baptisms that take place at Easter.









Greece Island of Corfu





On the morning of Holy Saturday, the traditional "pot throwing" takes place. People throw pots, pans, and other earthenware out of their windows, smashing them on the street. The tradition is to throw out what is old and have new life with the resurrection.









Spain (city or verges)







On Holy Thursday, the traditional "dansa de la mort" or "death dance" is performed. To reenact scenes from the Passion, everyone dresses in skeleton costumes and parades through the streets. The procession ends with frightening skeletons carrying boxes of ashes.









USA
(DC at the White house)







For over 130 years, this tradition has continued where children roll a colored hard-boiled egg with a large serving spoon across a grassy lawn.









Germany







Here the Easter eggs are displayed on trees and prominently in streets, with some of the trees having thousands of multi color eggs hanging on them.









Australia







Because this country thinks rabbits are a pest to crops, they have changed the Easter bunny to be the Easter bilby, which is a mouse with long ears. He has the same Easter duties.
