## EILEEN OCONNOR

Eileen O'Connor was born in Australia in 1892 and was crippled by a fall that injured her spine when she was only three years old. She was largely paralyzed for several years and remained in constant pain throughout her brief life. She was not even 4 feet tall because of it and for much of her life she could not stand or walk. Eileen's beautiful spirit inspired many people to seek her guidance and prayers. She listened to them, understood their problems and gave wise advice. Eileen's legacy is the mission of Our Lady's Nurses for the Poor that she founded and has been active for over the past 100 years. It ranks among the great and enduring social works of the Church in Australia. Her cause of canonization has been opened.
