### **KIND & NOT RUDE**

A TRUE FRIEND IS KIND AND NEVER DOES HARM TO HIS FRIEND IN HIS WORDS. A TRUE FRIEND IS NOT IMPOLITE TO HIS FRIEND; HE DOES NOT MAKE HIM FEEL BAD



### **NOT JEALOUS**

ON THE CONTRARY, FRIENDSHIP IS CAPABLE OF REJOICING WHEN ANOTHER PERSON DOES WELL OR IS HAPPY.



### **DOES NOT SEEK HIS OWN INTERESTS**

A TRUE FRIEND DOES NOT TAKE ADVANTAGE OF HIS FRIEND; HE DOESN'T LOOK FOR PERSONAL GAIN FROM THE RELATIONSHIP. ON THE CONTRARY, HE WANTS HIS



### **BEARS ALL THINGS**

A TRUE FRIEND HOPES FOR THE BEST FROM HIS FRIEND. HE HOPES FOR UNDERSTANDING, HELP, A LISTENING EAR, ADVICE, AND AVAILABILITY AT ANY TIME



### **NEVER FAILS**

TRUE FRIENDSHIP ENDURES FOR A LONG TIME. FALSE FRIENDSHIPS FADE EASILY.



### **DOES NOT DWELL ON INJURY**

HE QUICKLY FORGIVES AND DOES NOT HOLD A GRUDGE. HE TRUSTS IN HIM SINCE YOU KNOW HE DID NOT MAKE AN INTENTIONAL MISTAKE, AND THAT YOU TOO ARE CAPABLE OF MAKING MISTAKES LIKE HIM.



### **BELIEVES ALL THINGS**

A TRUE FRIEND TRULY BELIEVES IN HIS FRIEND. HE TRUSTS THAT HIS FRIEND TOO WANTS TO BUILD THE RELATIONSHIP AND MAKE IT BETTER. HE DOES NOT PUT A TWISTED SPIN ON EVERYTHING HIS FRIEND TELLS HIM, SINCE HE CARES FOR HIM AND KNOWS THAT HE IS GOOD.



### **NOT POMPOUS OR INFLATED**

A TRUE FRIEND DOESN'T BOAST IN FRONT OF HIS FRIEND. HE DOES NOT WISH TO FEEL SUPERIOR TO HIM, BUT EQUAL TO HIM.
