You will have to find ways of involving young people in projects and activities of formation, spirituality, and service, giving them responsibility for themselves and for their work, and taking care to avoid isolating them and their apostolate from the rest of the ecclesial community. Young people need to be able to see the practical relevance of their efforts to meet the real needs of people, especially the poor and neglected. They should be able to see that their apostolate belongs fully to the Church's mission in the world."

Our Adult Leader Book Guidebook is an aid to help you plan, organize and offer Challenge & Conquest to a great number of young people. Only God knows how many lives can be touched by your efforts and work to form these young apostles.



WHAT DO WE MEAN BY TEAM BASED AND TEEN LED?

Challenge and Conquest are designed so that you organize your youth group into smaller teams of about 10-15 teens, who are around the same age. Each team is led by one or two teen leaders who are usually 2 or 3 years older than the group they lead. This is small group mentoring & peer ministry where everything is done in teams especially the weekly activities & service projects. The youth minister & adult leaders work with the teen leaders training them & helping them prepare to lead their team activities each week. In this way the youth group could be large in number but no one will feel lost in the crowd because they are part of a team with a team leader looking out for them.

Peer mentoring is not only a life changing experience for the teen leaders, it truly makes an impact on the younger teens when they learn about their faith and see positive role models in their team leaders, who are only a few years older than they are.

CATHOLIC VIRTUE PROGRAM FOR BOYS K THRU 4th GRADE

The Conquest Junior Leadership Program is a weekly virtue based program run by dads and youth leaders for boys in kindergarten through 4th grade. The Junior Program can be run alongside a Conquest club on its own.

Conquest JR has its own unique curriculum, tshirts, bags, & commitment cards for the younger boys. The Conquest Jr Adult Leader Kit has all that is needed to run the program including the Curriculum Guide, point chips and commitment cards. A new addition in recent years are the virtue stickers given after each virtue campaign. By means of mentoring, the boys are guided through the age appropriate development of virtues such as respect, kindness, service and compassion, all while growing in leadership skills.

Each week there is an activity focused on the virtue of the specific campaign. There are seven parts to the Conquest JR weekly activity, which are different from the Conquest meeting. Point chips and positive motivation is encouraged.

The Junior Program is focused on the boys learning more about their Catholic Faith through virtues, stories of the saints and the bible. Each year the curriculum changes and we focus on five new virtues and saints, making up the Series 1, Series 2 and Series 3 curriculum for Conquest Jr. Each virtue campaign also includes virtue stickers that the boys can add to their commitment cards


A CATHOLIC FAITH AND VIRTUE PROGRAM FOR GIRLS IN KINDERGARTEN TO THE FOURTH GRADE.

Challenge JR is about helping the girls learn about their Catholic faith and Christian virtue through games, fun, lives of the saints and other activities. It is led by Adult Leaders [moms], with the help from teen mentors. We offer materials and a complete curriculum to help the girls and leaders successfully run the program each week. The curriculum can be found in the Adult Leader kit which contains the Guidebook, along with virtue posters, stickers, and other items to help.



The Challenge JR member kit has a member card, bracelet, tshirt, bag and a Prayer and Coloring book, to help the girls learn about faith and virtue.

The Challenge Jr Weekly Meeting has 8 different parts. There are moments for fun like the snack and group game. There are moments to learn about the virtue of the week and saint story. The girls will also learn about one Catholic prayer. There is even time for a virtue craft, all centered around a common theme.



Challenge Jr believes in the power of positive recognition and creating memories. We offer virtue charms, virtue stickers, holy cards and bracelets to help keep the girls excited about living their Catholic faith and Christian virtue.

Each year, the curriculum focuses on five virtues with five saints. Each week the girls learn about how to live that virtue either with God, at home, at school or with friends. They also learn Catholic prayers and have the opportunity to do service projects throughout the year.

NEW SERIES 3 CHALLENGE & CONQUEST ADVENT & LENT TEAM LEADER BOOKS

In 2017-18, we made an addition to our team leader kits and curriculum - the new Advent and Lent Team Leader Guidebook. We listened to the requests of the leaders to add in themes and activities that could help the young people live the seasons of Advent and Lent each year. So this year we have continued with that same addition for this years' 2019 Advent and 2020 Lenten seasons. Every team leader kit includes this new special book. The themes and gospel reflections go along with the 2019- 20 liturgy readings for Sunday Mass and there are new games and icebreakers with a seasonal theme as well.

Challenge also offers an additional guidebook in each team leader kit that focuses on the Virtue and Saint of the Month. This guidebook has ten Challenge Meetings about the specific virtue of the month. The activities, games and content will help the girls learn more about Christian virtues and modern day saints. It is meant to be used each month as a compliment to the regular curriculum, and ideally at the first meeting of the month.
