Team Challenge Submission and Tracking: Teams will submit photo evidence of a completed challenge to ECYDLeaderboard@gmail.com. The submission will be reviewed and then recorded on the leaderboard every two weeks.

# **Competition Rules:**

#### **Teams**

- Teams must consist of at least 3 members and up to 15 members. Any team larger than 15 members must divide into two or more teams.
- Team members may be added throughout the year through the online registration.
- Teams must consist of ECYD members or participants of ECYD programs (Challenge, Conquest, LTP, etc.).
- Teams must be single sex. No co-ed teams.

### Challenge Submission

- Team leaders must submit photo evidence of a completed challenge to ECYDLeaderboard@gmail.com.
- All challenges must be submitted within 30days of completing the challenge.
- Completed challenge submissions must include <u>the team</u> name and city of residence, date of completion, number of team members who participated, and the name of the <u>challenge(s) completed</u>.

### Example submission:

"Team Convicted4Christof Cincinnati completed the "Go to mass together" challenge on January 12th. 4 of our 5 members participated. See attached photo of our team."

- If photo evidence is not possible, the ECYD director or club leader must verify that the challenge was competed by sending an email on behalf of the team to ECYDLeaderboard@gmail.com.
- Team leaders will receive a confirmation email after the submission is reviewed.
- All scores will be final as of 11:59pm on October 31st, 2022.
   No submissions will be accepted after the deadline.

## Scoring

- After the completed challenge submission is reviewed, points will be awarded to the team and recorded on the leaderboard online.
- With a few exceptions, challenges are worth 2, 4, or 6 points.
- Challenges may be repeated once every month. The same challenge cannot be completed more than once in the same month.
- Depending on the number of team members who participated in the challenge, teams will receive either full points or half of the points. See the table below for participation requirements.

#### Example:

A team with 7 members will receive half points if at least 4 members participate in the challenge. The team will receive full points if at least 6 members participate in the challenge.
